England Hockey is proud to be hosting the Men's & Women's EuroHockey Championships at our Olympic legacy venue, Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre in August 2015.

We are delighted to confirm that alongside this event England Hockey will be hosting the EuroHockey Masters at all Men's and Women's Masters and Grand Masters age groups.

Initial details of the competitions are included below and we look forward to welcoming teams to London for a great festival of hockey next year.

The competitions

In conjunction with WGMA and IMHA tournaments for the following age groups will be run:

• EuroHockey Masters Championships

Women's - 40+, 45+, 50+, 55+ Men's - 40+, 45+, 50+, 55+

• EuroHockey Grand Masters Championships

Women's - 60+

Men's - 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+.

In addition Tournament Trophy competitions for the Men's 60+, 65+, 70+ age groups are planned. Entry to these tournaments will be open to non-European teams and European "B" teams.

Dates

The start date for the EuroHockey Masters is Saturday 22 August 2015. All tournaments will be concluded by Friday 28 August 2015.

Match schedules

Match schedules are of course dependent on entry levels and we aim to provide details of these in line with the timeline overleaf. Matches will be scheduled where possible so teams can watch their senior teams in the EuroHockey Championships and priority tickets will be made available to teams.















Venues

The three venues planned to play host to the competitions are St Albans, Southgate and Old Loughtonians. All are within reasonable proximity to Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre and have two waterbased or sand dressed pitches, great clubhouses as well as the infrastructure to run memorable tournaments. A full programme of social events will be run alongside the hockey.
