This year we have Belgium, England, France, Germany, Ireland, Netherlands, Russia and Spain competing in the men's championship and Belgium, England, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Poland, Scotland and Spain in the women's.

## Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park

## Velopark

The Velopark to your right hosted the cycling events during the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, the shape of the track is shown by the shape of the roof which follows the same lines and looks like a well known potato based snack! The track itself is held together with 350,000 nails.
